

CONFESSION

Like the people who greeted Jesus as he entered Jerusalem and then later pronounced "Crucify him," we are fickle people who often deny Christ in our thoughts, words, and deeds.

Remembering the events of Jesus' last week helps us see ourselves for what we are: sinners in need of a Savior, a Savior we have in Christ. In honesty and hope, let us now confess our sins to God.

Yet, Lord, we confess that the mouths that seek to praise you often deny or defy you.


And we confess that the hands that seek to serve you often become fists, incapable of extending your mercy.
